St. Richard Theatre Company Celebrates 30th Anniversary with *Good News!*

Good News takes center stage March 19-21 and March 26-28 at St. Richard School Auditorium in North Olmsted as the St. Richard Theatre Company celebrates its 30th year of productions.

Good News is a “flip, fast, furious and free” vintage 1920’s musical! Featuring zany characters, a whacky plot and period dancing, the show brings to life Tait College in 1928 where football is all the rage and great old songs just keep coming: “Button Up Your Overcoat”, “Together”, “Lucky Star”, “The Best Things in Life are Free” and “Life is Just a Bowl of Cherries” to name a few.

The Broadway production of *Good News* opened in 1927 and ran for over 500 performances. The Broadway revival opened in 1974 for only 16 performances, but in 1993, the Musical Theatre of Wichita’s stage version became the most popular and included a studio cast recording released in 1995. MGM released two film versions, the first in 1930 and a remake in 1947.

Artistic Director Nathan A. Lilly celebrates his 12th season and 17th production with St. Richard Theatre Company while Robin Kunikis makes her directing debut during the Company’s milestone year. “This period production is a comedic spectacle when an unlikely love connection strikes between a star football player and a college co-ed bookworm, set within the context of college football,” said Kunikis. Along with Kunikis, Lilly also serves as Stage Manager and is joined by Choreographer Nicci Cassara and Music Director Brad Wyner. The cast and crew of more than 50 students range in ages from nine to 14.
